1. Mark Harper from Bureau of Fire Standards and Training –
 - a. Job Task Analysis update
 - b. RFQ received 1 submission and a special review board has been implemented to rate and advised if accepted
 - c. Standards rule test day, hopefully signed off by July as it is with the attorneys
 - d. PO forms are progressing there is no target date
 - e. CEU's for instructors, State will be implementing new form which will document for the lead only. The form will be able to document multiple classes for a max of 20 hours (same process for class approval)
 - i. Asked about using verification of hours for standards is possible... due to the forms being outdated right now unreasonable
 - f. Best practices, students not showing up, still issues with the ladder, cameras on evaluators working have lessened the conflict and court time.
 - g. State is now emailing students test confirmation approval instead of snail mail
